Grow your mobile list

Easily enable your donors to subscribe to your mobile messaging program when they donate through an ActBlue web form.

- | Donors who check the mobile opt-in option will be enrolled into a Mobile Commons opt-in path
- | Automatically thank donors via SMS after they opt-in to messages via ActBlue
- | Easily track who joined your list through ActBlue
- | Utilize this method as an always-on opt-in path or for special campaigns and events

Optimize fundraising campaigns

Engage supporters beyond the donation to build lasting relationships, mobilize supporters, and drive repeat giving.

- | Enroll new mobile subscribers into a welcome series to improve retention longterm
- | Identify those who opted-in via ActBlue, then engage them with targeted campaigns to drive action, attract volunteers, and mobilize voters
- | Optimize fundraising efforts by using donation data to improve targeting, deliver compelling donation asks, and reinvigorate dormant donors
- | Sync donation data in real-time to trigger thank you messages, continue education efforts, or the share a new call to action

How it works

Using a webhook we are able to trigger an opt-in path within Mobile Commons when a donor checks the mobile opt-in box on an ActBlue form.

Once a supporter opts-in to your mobile program, key profile and donation data will be synced to Mobile Commons, including:

- | First and last name
- | Phone number
- | Email address
- | Street address, city, state, zip, and country
- | Historical and real-time donation data, including date, time and amount

Pricing

There is a one-time setup fee to get your organization up and running with the ActBlue webhook for Mobile Commons. From that point forward, all data syncing is free!
